They can also review, adjust and approve orders within the system. Similarly, SMX implemented a complex approval process for orders and a follow-up subsystem to automate most interactions with customers, suppliers, carriers and auditors through a supplier community and an email alert system.

And finally integrate Salesforce with the local ERP system.
